TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) Eligibility: All teams must consist of carded players as per your NOHA House League roster sheets. Any over age players with above average skills will not be allowed to play
- 2) Before the Festival, teams must produce player, coach, trainer cards and travel permits.
- 3) CAHA, OHF, NOHA and KLMHA rules are in effect
- 4) Conflicting colours: The visiting team will be provided with singlets to wear over their sweaters, provided by the committee.
- 5) This is a fun day festival and there should not be any disputes; however, if there are all disputes will be settled by the Rules Committee. Referee's decisions are final. PROTESTS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
 - i. All games shall consist of 8 minutes of straight time 3 on 3.
 - ii. Teams will play against teams at or near their own skill level.
- 6) All teams shall be ready to play 10 minutes before game time.
- 7) Any player that conducts him or herself in behaviour that would normally constitute a major, match or gross misconduct penalty shall be ejected from the game and the remainder of the Festival.
- 8) Awards: all players are expected to be in uniform on the ice following the final game for the presentation of awards to all players.
